



### TEMPERATURE

The average maximum temperature for Brunei is **32.0°C** and the average minimum temperature is **23.7°C**.

On 28<sup>th</sup> March 1983, with highest temperature ever recorded in Brunei was **38.0°C**.

While, the lowest temperature recorded in the history of Brunei was **18.4°C** on 13<sup>th</sup> January 1985.

### RAINFALL



The highest amount of monthly rainfall recorded was in January 2009 with the amount of **977.0 mm**.

On 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019 at BIA Station, the highest daily rainfall recorded was **275.0 mm**. It resulted in flash floods especially at the low lying areas.

The longest days without rain recorded was for **31 days** from 1st to 31st March 1998.



### WIND SPEED

9th June 2001 at 7:36 pm, the highest wind speed ever recorded at BIA was **113.9 km/h** (equivalent to **61.5 knots**) which according to the World Meteorological Organization classification and Beaufort Wind Scale, it is considered as Violent Storm.

### HAZE

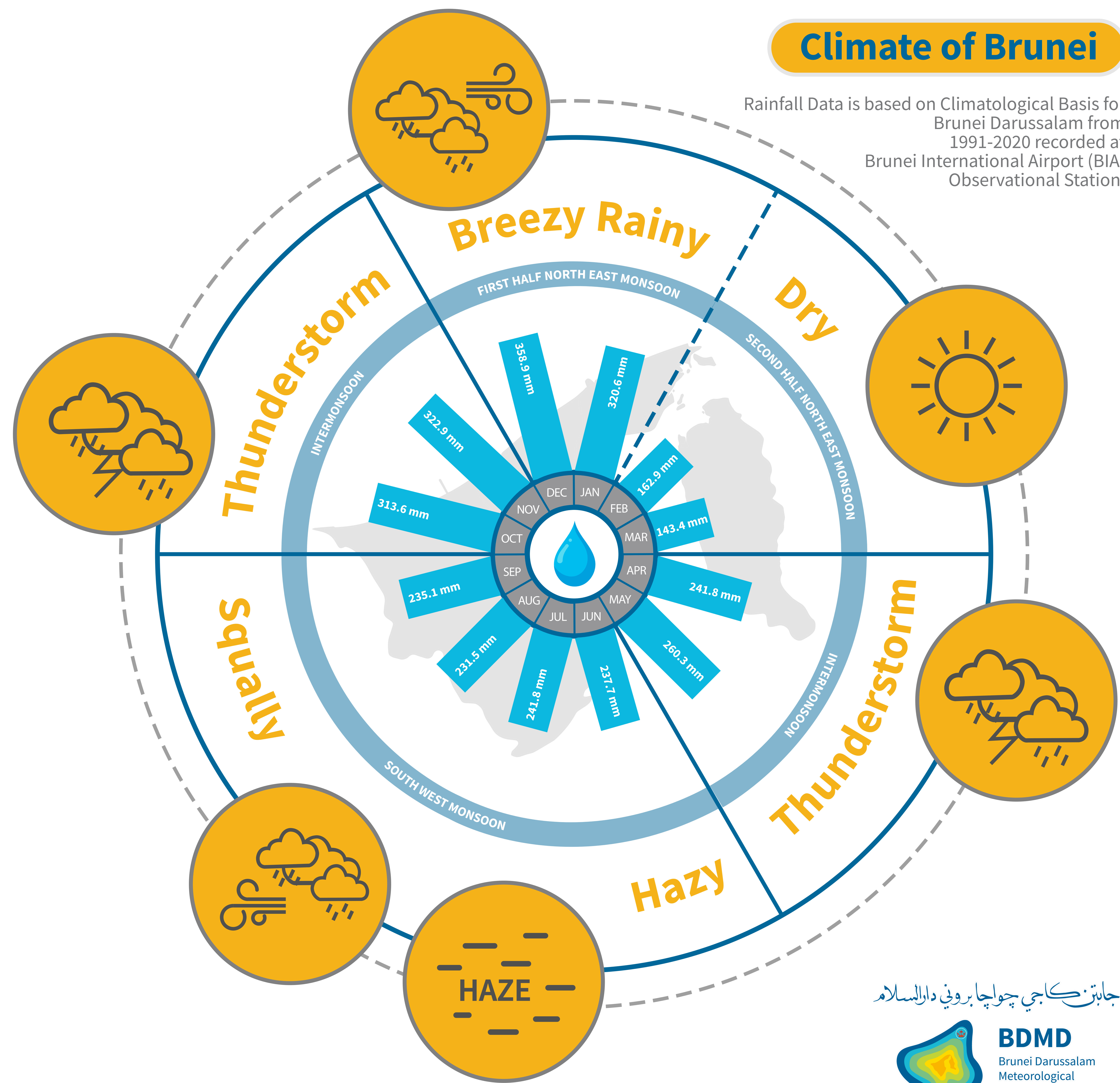


The worst haze ever recorded was with **100m** visibility (that's as long as a football pitch!) on 14th April 1997, 24th March 1998 and 8th April 1998. Schools were closed and all members of the general public were required to wear their masks and keep themselves hydrated at all times.

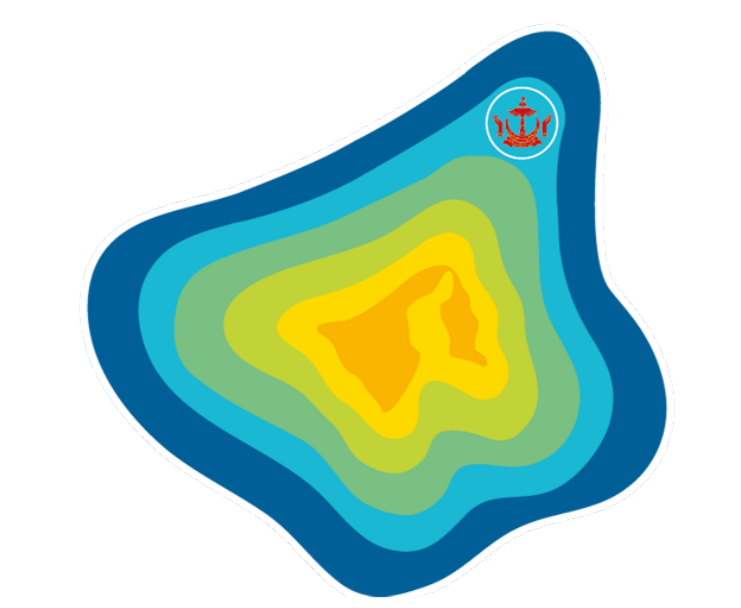
